Farndon Fields Sports Day - Wednesday, 18th June

The next exciting event on the calendar is the Farndon Fields Sports Day, taking place on Wednesday, 18th June. Although we were kindly invited to join Kibworth's sports day as well, we decided to attend only Farndon Fields for logistical transport reasons. The Sports Day will start at 9:15 am, with families welcome to spectate. Please consider arranging car shares between families so that everyone can meet at Farndon Fields at 9:15 am. Street Parking is limited around the school.

If you wish to use Jetsetters Breakfast Club on the morning of the 18th, you can still do so, and we will transport the Jetsetter children to Farndon Fields. If this applies to you, please inform Jetsetters in advance.

The plan for the day is as follows: after the Sports Day finishes at 11:15 am, our Wellington children will stay at Farndon Fields to enjoy lunch with the Farndon Fields children. Following lunch, we will walk to Welland Park for some outdoor games in the sunshine and treat them to an ice cream. We kindly ask that you collect your child from Welland Park Tennis Courts at 3:15 pm. We are looking forward to what promises to be a great day out for everyone!

Teddy Bear's Picnic Afternoon - Friday, 4th July


