

Year 1 handwriting

In Year 1, handwriting is systematically integrated into phonics sessions. Teachers diligently instruct children on the correct formation of letters, emphasising the importance of a comfortable and efficient pencil grip. Children are taught to leave precise spaces between words. By the end of Year 1, students will be capable of writing legibly, upper and lower-case letters appropriately, and ensuring correct spacing between words. This approach facilitates a seamless transition to the Nelson's handwriting scheme.

Capital letters:

Lower case letters:

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z
