Literacy: Writing Progression Road Map

On Entry

Shows a preference for a dominant hand.

Draws pre-writing shapes.

Hear and write the initial sounds in words.

Write many of the letters in their name.

Write many recognisable letters accurately.

Form most lower-case and some capital letters correctly.

Write short, dictated phrases using words with known sound-letter correspondences.

ELG- Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

Make suggestions as to how their work could be improved.

ELG- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.

Use common exception words, spelt correctly, including I, the, a, he, she, to.

Compose own simple sentences, beginning to use simple conjunctions (e.g. and, but) and linking sentences.

ELG- Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

Write short, dictated Phrases and sentences using words with known sound-letter correspondences using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.
